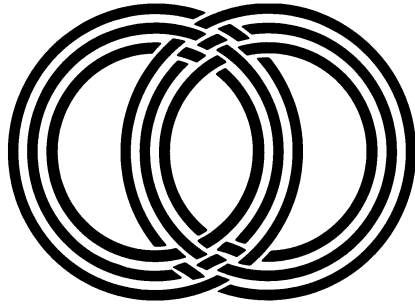


DIALOGUE
