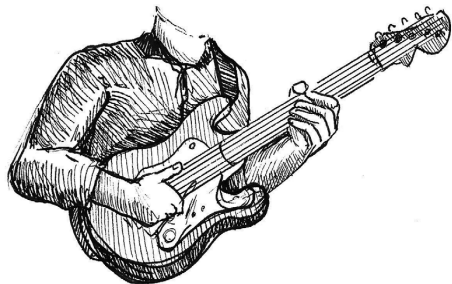

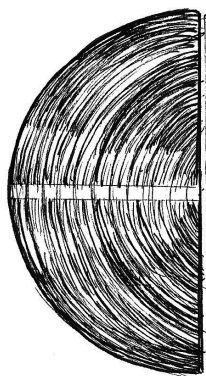


Bulletin of the Council for Research in Music Education

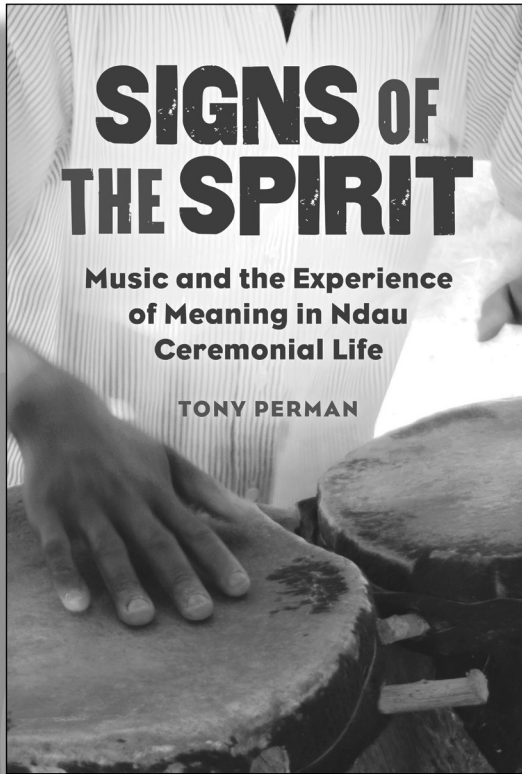

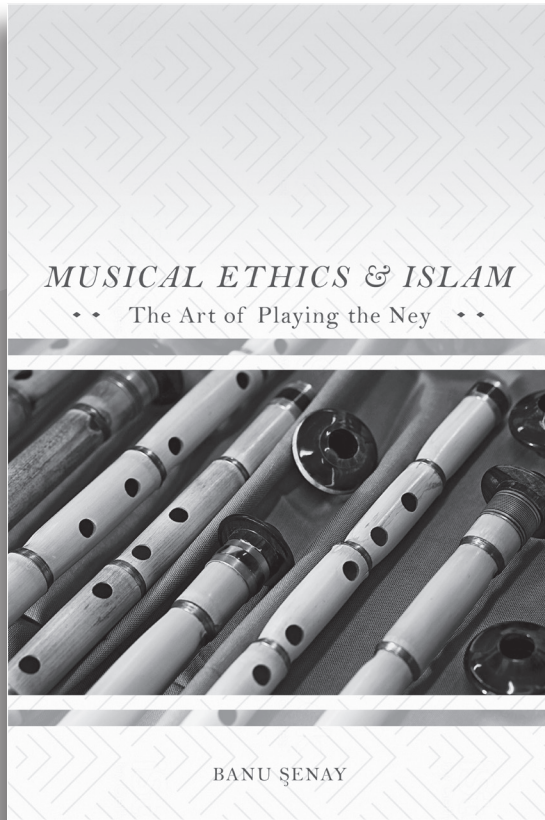

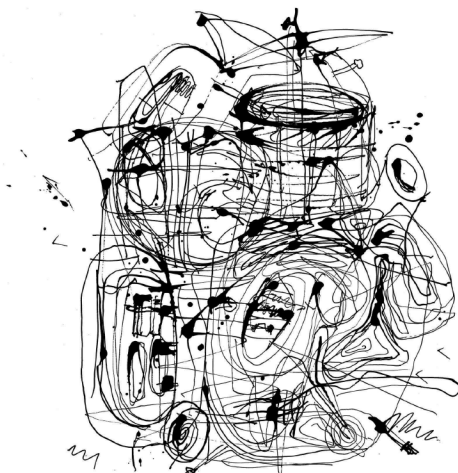
