Articles average 12,000 words (including notes) but we have accepted articles from 4,000 to 15,000 words. The *Journal* prefers to work with electronic files of manuscripts. 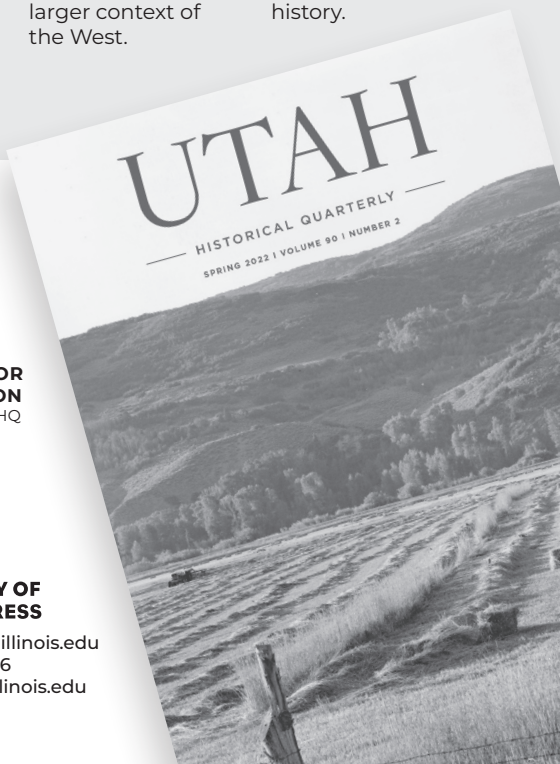
