2) the development of liberal religious thought in America.





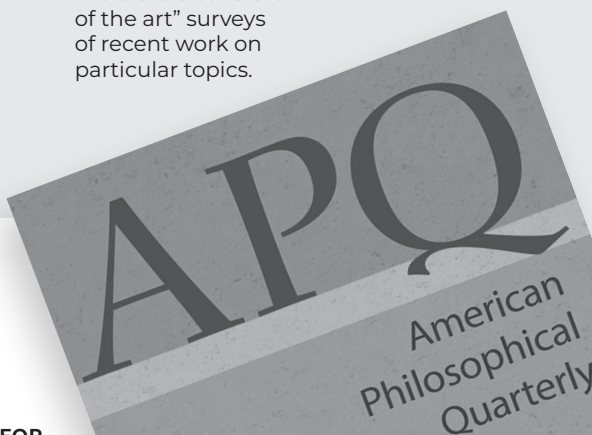

HPQ specializes in papers that cultivate philosophical history with a strong interaction between contemporary and historical concerns.

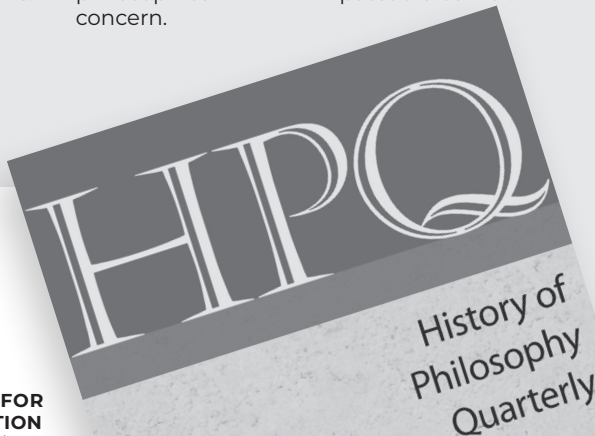
Contributors regard work in the history of philosophy and in philosophy itself as parts of a seamless whole—historical inquiry and ongoing philosophical concern.
