Submissions should be no longer than 6,000 to 10,000 words plus notes, tables, etc. They should include an abstract of approximately 250 words. Manuscripts are evaluated on the basis of their originality; relevance to the mission of the journal; the clarity of the thesis, presentation, and conclusions; and the scope of research.
