



Krannert Art Museum is located on the campus of the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign and a unit within the College of Fine and Applied Arts. A significant part of the Museum's permanent collection of 9,000 works of art is displayed in ten galleries, ranging from ancient Egyptian art to contemporary photographs. In addition, the Museum presents 12-15 changing exhibitions each year, bringing works of art from other museums and collections, both nationally and internationally, to the community.
